WHEREAS, the Annual Budget as introduced reflects Total Revenues of \$5,592,109.95 which includes an amount to be raised by taxation of \$4,716,459.14 and Total Appropriations of \$5,592,109.95; and

WHEREAS, the amount to be raised by taxation to support the district budget shall be the amount to be certified to the assessor of the municipality to be assessed against the taxable property in the district, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:14-79. Such amount shall be equal to the amount of the total appropriations set forth in the budget minus the total amount surplus and miscellaneous revenues set forth in the budget; and

WHEREAS, in calculating the amount to be raised by taxation, the Fire District has taken into account the assessed valuation of taxable property in the Fire District;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Commissioners of the Fire District, at an open public meeting held on December 9, 2024 that the Annual Budget, including all related schedules, of the Fire District for the fiscal year beginning January 1, 2025 and ending December 31, 2025 is hereby approved; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the anticipated revenues as reflected in the Annual Budget are of sufficient amount to meet all proposed expenditures/expenses and all covenants, terms and provisions as stipulated in the Fire District's outstanding debt obligations, capital lease arrangements, service contracts, and other pledged agreements; and

The District's appropriations increase \$1,869,918.50, primarily due to voter approved capital spending of \$1,700,000. Anticipated revenues increase \$1,869,918.50 due to grants of \$450,000, and total fund balance utilized of 356,765.81. Amount raised by taxation increases \$1,162,844.18

election costs decrease \$3,000 due to less special elections being held in 2025. office expense increases \$4,000 due to additional costs of items. Email maintenance increases \$1,120 due to increased use of e-mail communications between staff and commissioners. ADP payroll process fees increase to \$4,200 due to the outsourcing of payroll duties in 2025. Medical cost decrease due to less staff being eligible for coverage. Legal fees will decrease due to less work needed for personnel matters. professional services increase \$10,000 due to increased clerical costs. Insurance costs increase \$12,500 based on quotes received from insurance carriers. Fire service costs increase \$40,000 based upon increased rates by water company as well as additional hydrants put in district in 2025. Other revenue increases \$449,000 due to one time grant to be received to offset cost of new water rescue boat. Fringe benefits increase because health benefits cost increase 16%, as well as higher payroll taxes based on higher pay for firefighters. FPB Miscellaneous increase due to increased training costs. Fire Equipment testing increases \$2,000 based upon prior years experience and better tracking of costs. Communications/Technology cost decrease \$2,000 due to better technology since the improvement of township phone/server. The Township/Phone server costs decrease because all of the work needed for this was completed in 2024.

The District will utilize \$56,765.81 in unrestricted fund balance, as well as \$300,000 in restricted reserves. This will partially offset the amount to be raised by taxation, which will increase \$1,1162,844.18, primarily due to the capital budget increase of \$1,700,000. These actions will not have an impact on the 2026 budget.

The District is levy cap compliant.

The District will utilize \$300,000 in restricted fund balance to offset the capital items costing \$1,700,000.

The District is budgeting \$1,735,000 in capital appropriations, of which \$1,700,000 was approved by the district voters at a special meeting held on December 2, 2024. Debt service will remain level in 2025.
